

WELCOME TO THE CITY OF BONITA SPRINGS

BARK -N- PLAY PARK

This park is set aside solely as an off-lead play area. This park is self-monitoring by dog park users.

The City of Bonita Springs reserves the right to refuse entry to dogs and their owner/handler for the reasons of health, safety, and prior rule violations, or for the comfort of all patrons and their pets. All dogs must have current vaccinations, be licensed, free of parasites, infections, and **MUST WEAR A COLLAR WITH ID AND CURRENT LICENSE TAG.**

Entry into the off-lead area is at the risk of dog owner. Dog owners are responsible and liable for any injury and/or damage to property, persons, or other animals caused by their dog(s). The City of Bonita Springs **WILL NOT** be responsible for injuries to visiting dogs, their owners or others using the park. Prevent problems by supervising your dog at all times. All bites to people must be reported to Lee County Animal Services.

Dogs and their owner/handler who violate the following rules are subject to removal from the Park:

All dogs must be leashed within the parking areas and when entering or exiting off-leash areas of Bark-N-Play Park

Dogs must be in view of and within voice control of their owner/handler at all times. Owner/handler must remain in fenced area with their dog(s). Owners must stop aggressive dog behavior immediately

Gates to the off-leash areas shall be kept closed at all times

Aggressive dogs, females dogs in heat, puppies under (4) months old and sick dogs are prohibited in Bark-N-Play Park

All dog waste anywhere within the park boundaries must be picked up promptly. Waste bags are provided. Non-compliance will result in owner and dog being required to leave the park

Children under the age of twelve (12) must be accompanied by an adult

Children under 5 should not be brought into fenced/off-lead area

Children should not run or interfere with dogs at play

No more than two dogs per person may enter Bark-N-Play Park at any time

Dogs must be kept in the appropriate section of Bark-N-Play Park: small dog (under 25 pounds), medium dog (25-50 pounds), and large dog (over 50 pounds)

Bark-N-Play Park may be closed for routine maintenance and City sponsored events.

No smoking or food of any kind is permitted in Bark-N-Play Park.
