



Weatherization Works in Florida

Weatherization Assistance Program

Eligible Lee County households can receive up to \$5,000.00 in energy-saving improvements to their home through the Weatherization Assistance Program.

The mission of the program is to reduce the monthly energy burden on low-income households by improving the energy efficiency of the home. Types of improvements available through the program may include addressing air infiltration issues (weather stripping, caulking, repairing or replacing ceilings, floors, windows, or doors); installing attic ventilation or solar screens; repairing or replacing inefficient heating units, cooling units, or water heaters.

In order to qualify for the program, total household income may not be more than 200% of national poverty guidelines. Preference is given to owner-occupied homes, elderly (60 or older) or physically disabled residents, families with children ages 12 and under, and households with a high energy burden (repeated high utility bills).
