The City of Bonita has identified three sites for the debris in order to meet the challenge of removing this large amount of debris. The more sites the drivers have to dump debris, the quicker the process.

The city continues to look for opportunities for sites throughout the city. The city has identified sites at Tower Rd., a lot south of River Park and the Bamboo lot downtown. These sites give the city central, west and east locations.

The downtown site is for horticultural debris only, items like trees and branches. The construction and demo debris, roofs etc. is taken straight to a waste transfer site in Naples.

What is the process for the bamboo site?

Horticultural debris gets dumped on the site.



The drivers off load it themselves with grapples, then pile it.



Then it is chipped and hauled in dump trucks in approximately 100 cubic yard semi-trailers to the final site, which makes compost soil, this results in cost savings.



The bamboo site will have turnover to it. The City hopes to have the debris downtown as short of a timeline as possible. Once the shorter hauls are completed, the operation will default to the larger sites. This site will help the downtown area quicken the recovery process. The City is still actively pursuing other sites.

The focus continues to be on recovery, the more sites that are open, the quicker the debris is picked up. This also assists with being able to give more information to the public regarding scheduling and maps.
