BikeWalkLee to present the “Complete Streets Champion of the Year”

Awarded to Bonita Springs Deputy Mayor, Peter R. O’Flinn.

Bonita Springs, Florida- December 13, 2018- BikeWalkLee will present Bonita Springs Deputy Mayor Peter R. O’Flinn with its “Complete Streets Champion of the Year” award at the Bonita Springs City Council meeting on December 19 at 9 a.m.

The award recognizes Mr. O’Flinn’s leadership on key transportation initiatives. They include the ongoing project to transform West Terry Street into a beautiful and safer multimodal corridor for schoolchildren, bicyclists and drivers alike; working with the Florida Department of Transportation on plans to improve traffic flow at the clogged Bonita Beach Rd/ US 41 intersection; and collaborating with the Village of Estero to launch a long term effort for a ten-mile “rails to trail” connecting the two municipalities.

BikeWalkLee presents the “Complete Streets Champion of the Year” award annually to a person or group that has provided outstanding leadership or significant contributions to the decade long effort to implement complete streets throughout Lee County.
