a. Website Update

Mr. Deaton would like to suggest eliminating the popup when you first log into the site.

Mr. Deaton stated when searching on the site, a window will come up with different selections. You cannot widen the window; you can scroll up and down, but not left and right.

The site indicates that documents are .docx, but everything he has downloaded is .doc. Mr. Deaton liked the fact that the documents are .doc.

Mr. Deaton does not like clicking on the menu at the top and would prefer having the menu items listed at the top. Mr. Smelko stated that happens on mobile devices. Mr. Kauffman stated that was on his PC. Mr. Smelko will look into this

Mr. Deaton when he starts down the page, as soon as he gets down to it, it starts turning around. He states this is very distracting.

Mr. Deaton states the red banner at the top does not go away.

Mr. Deaton would like to see a home button at the left hand corner of every page. Mr. Smelko advised that the City logo is the home button. Mr. Deaton would like to see it clearly stated "home".

Mr. Deaton states the search engine is extremely slow and fails intermittently. Additionally, he tried to find someone's email and could not. Mr. Smelko stated they do not put emails on the website for fishing; however, the City Clerk's email is on the website. Mr. Deaton recommended that email addresses be added back on.

Mr. Deaton found that multiple drill downs ended up with a greyed-out screen and does not believe it is the operating systems or his browser. Mr. Smelko will look into it.

Mr. Deaton asked what a District subscription is. Mr. Smelko stated if they ever wanted to send a mass email to a particular district, they have a list. Mr. Deaton stated it is not clear.

Mr. Smelko will take a note of Mr. Deaton's concerns and talk to Ms. Taylor.

Mr. Smelko announced that they have an app coming out soon. Mr. Kauffman recommended that Board download the app and be prepared with comments at the next meeting.

Mr. Deaton is going to email staff information he collected on web crawlers and asked staff to forward to the Board.
