Ms. Bickel asked if anyone had had a chance to listen to the link that Mr. Smelko sent out of the October Zoning Board Meeting regarding the cell tower. Ms. Bickel noted that the primary discussion for the hour was about the availability of service, but what was troubling was that, although noted in section 4-1225(b) on the screen, they did not discuss the issue of public safety. LDC 4-1225(b) states: "The special exception is necessary to ensure adequate public safety and emergency management communications". Ms. Bickel stated this issue was not discussed at all or used as justification for the tower and Ms. Bickel thinks this is the primary reason to approve the request.

Mr. Gibson stated the Zoning Board approved the request for a variance for the tower and the case is scheduled to go before City Council for approval.

Mr. Kauffman asked if Ms. Bickel would like to make a resolution inside of this Board, to use LDC 4-1225(b) for the citation as the criterion for accepting or rejecting requests for cell towers. Ms. Bickel would like to have seen the issue of public safety specifically addressed.

Ms. Bickel stated that she would like to use LDC Section 4-1225(b) as the criteria for accepting the building of towers that exceed the size limit as outlined in Zoning ordinance, Mr. Deaton seconded, motion passed unanimously.

Discussion ensued regarding cell tower coverage and the ability to dial 911. Mr. Deaton stated that single strength and capacity are both necessary for adequate public safety communication. Mr. Gibson stated that Council has already asked Community Development to come up with new language regarding cell towers and public safety.

Mr. Kauffman made a motion to remove the previous resolution since Council has addressed it, all in favor, motion passed unanimously.
