**Traffic preemption for emergency vehicles**— Chairman Kauffman called Mr. Price, who is leading this effort for Lee County, to inquire about the grant application but the county did not receive a grant this time. They have another application in but will not hear anything until this Fall. This project needs to be done on a county basis as it makes sense that it is a county function.

**Cell tower heights** – Community Development attended a previous meeting and was asked to see what other options are feasible. Would like to invite CD back to address more realistic standards.

Tim Deaton will send information out again to see if committee can develop something themselves.

Councilman Corrie will work with committee to develop green sheet to go before council to direct staff to do an update to the code that would allow for higher cell towers.

## **Electric Vehicles**

Committee member Poldoian reviewed sites he feels would be good locations for charging stations in this city. He has submitted five suggested locations to Electrify America but they are still in the review process. He has also submitted to EvGO.

Committee member Poldoian mentioned both high speed and level 2 chargers at Miromar Outlets. He believes the level two chargers are free.

Committee discussed incentives for electric vehicle charging stations in relation to the federal government, private sector, and individual communities.

Key to moving forward is making sure there are no unnecessary impediments from the city to installing of charging stations. The board has no evidence of any impediments, but wishes to be proactive in monitoring this.
