Council Member Greg DeWitt entered a motion finding extraordinary conditions exist, to allow Council Member Forbes to participate via phone; Council Member Peter O'Flinn seconded; and the motion carried unanimously.
III. DISCUSSION OF WCI COMMUNITIES, LLC, AND WCI COMMUNITIES, INC. V. CITY OF BONITA SPRINGS, FLORIDA, LEE COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CASE NUMBER 17-CA-3966 AND DIRECTION TO STAFF.

9:02:33 AM City Attorney Derek Rooney furnished an update on the case, informing Council that the proposed settlement offer to WCI has been rejected yesterday, and that there were some additional conditions that were outside of the original discussions and settlement authority Council granted him. He is hopeful that they can continue discussions and work towards a resolution with WCI.

9:03:16 AM He continued that they were ordered into mandatory arbitration, as there has been an arbitration decision made, and the City has 10 days from that decision to choose whether to challenge that decision. He has conferred with outside counsel David Theriaque and they recommend that Council does not challenge that determination at this time. That would provide more opportunity to continue to work towards a solution with WCI without rushing into decisions.

Council Member Laura Carr motioned to accept the arbitration; Council Member DeWitt seconded; and the motion carried unanimously.
