I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Ben Nelson, Jr., called the meeting to order at 5:35 P.M. There were approximately 80 members of the public in attendance.

II. **ROLL CALL:**

III. **PRESENTATION:**

Frank Cassidy, City Staff, facilitated the workshop. He began by providing an outline of the workshop which would include a PowerPoint presentation on the plans and a short film. Representatives with Wright Construction were in attendance to respond to the total 27 questions submitted prior to the meeting to address traffic flow, medians, and general questions.

Mr. Powell next furnished a PowerPoint presentation (copy in Clerk's file) on the redevelopment project, along with a short film on other completed redevelopment projects in other areas of the country. He explained that this was the third public meeting held. They are now in the process of putting together a price for City Council.

The intent is to develop a pedestrian friendly project utilizing the concept of complete streets. They have eliminated traffic signals and utilized roundabouts, which promote safety, slow traffic, act as a centerpiece for surrounding development, serve pedestrian mobility, etc. Mike Wallwork responded to several questions relating to roundabouts. Discussion was also held on medians which act to calm traffic, provide aesthetics, and act as a safe harbor for pedestrians crossing the street. Discussion was also held on drainage, underground utilities, setbacks, bike safety, etc. Representatives with Wright Construction responded to questions.

There being no further discussion, the workshop adjourned at 8:45 P.M.
