3. Staff Presentations on Transportation & Community Aesthetics Capital Improvement Projects

Presenting on Transportation projects, Assistant City Manager Matt Feeney, provided status updates on path/sidewalk projects and network expansion projects that are underway throughout the City. Additionally, he presented on signage projects that are planned in accordance with the City's new Wayfinding Signage and Gateway Feature Master Plan.

Nicole Perino, Director of Parks & Recreation, provided a PowerPoint presentation on Parks capital improvement projects. Beginning with the Baseball Complex, Phase I and II completed accomplishments include turf and fencing replacement, irrigation upgrades, new dugouts, and LED lighting upgrades. She also reviewed plans for Phase III renovations and noted that budget outyears include funding for additional renovations beyond Phase III. Director Perino also reviewed the following planned projects:

- Hickory Circle Landscaping*
- Riverside Park Bandshell Renovations*
- Soccer Complex Concession and Restroom Renovations*
- Community Park Playground and Tennis Court Resurfacing and Fencing*
- Depot Park Playground Renovation and Expansion*

Council provided direction by consensus to move forward with the identified Transportation and Parks projects.




