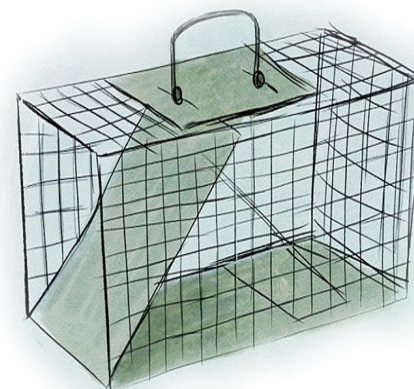
Trap-Neuter- Return Program

Humane Cat Trap

be secured with a chain and lock
to prevent possible theft. A \$75
refundable deposit is required. A
Check or credit card number will
be held on deposit, and not
cashed or processed unless the
trap is not returned.

Bonita Springs TNR Program

You can dramatically improve the lives of outdoor cats (and your neighborhood) by participating in the Trap-Neuter-Release Program when needed.

This Program is FREE!

The City of Bonita Springs provides vouchers for residents to use the feral (wild) cat Trap-Neuter-Return Program through Animal Hospital of Bonita.



These feral kittens were rescued by members of City Staff, and they all found loving homes!

Steps to take to use the Program

1. Humane cat traps can be obtained from the Animal Hospital of Bonita at 8830 Emerald Isle, Bonita Springs.
2. Set the trap for the homeless cats with food to attract them. Cover the trap with a blanket or towel to keep the cat out of direct sunlight. Never leave the trap in the sun which will harm or even kill the animal. Keep the Towel over the cage when traveling to lessen the cat's fear.
3. The cat is then brought to Dr. Linda Kitchen, DVM at the Animal Hospital of Bonita. Please call her office at 239-947-3447 to schedule a time to bring the cat in..
4. Cats are sterilized, micro chipped, vaccinated for rabies, and provided boosters. An ear tip will be performed by the Veterinarian to identify cats already sterilized.
5. Please return the cat to its neighborhood.
